6. WSB ENGINEER REPORT—Kevin Kruger

Kevin reported that plans are ready to advertise for bids on the 105th Street NW Road Project. Supervisor Loidolt made a motion to approve WSB to advertise for bids for the 105th Street NW Road project; Supervisor Arndt seconded; motion carried.

After receiving several emails from Elsworth and Patty Boe regarding the condition of Jackle Road, the Board contacted Hanson Paving who graded the road twice last week and dragged it again on Friday. Supervisor Loidolt viewed the road and reported that it is passable and in good condition.

7. DEPARTMENT OF LAND SERVICES

- Rezoning Request: 7655 Jasmine Loop
Resident is requesting to rezone approximately 2.5 acres on Jasmine Loop from residential to commercial to accommodate the operation of his business, A&T’s Tree and Landscape Service. The Board concurred that spot-zoning is not desirable in this area and the business would be a disturbance to other residents. The Clerk will notify Roxanne Achmann prior to the public hearing tomorrow morning.
- Farm Rite Ag Business
The Board is in favor of the farm implement business opening and operating on the west side of Highway 10, south of Henkemeyer landfill.

8. SAUK RAPIDS 2026-2027 FIRE PROTECTION CONTRACT

Supervisor Loidolt made a motion to approve the Sauk Rapids 2026-2027 Fire Protection Contract; Supervisor Arndt seconded; motion carried.

9. SUGAR DADDY’S LIQUOR LICENSE REQUEST

10. BERTRAM SPRAY PATCHING QUOTE FOR 2026

2026 quote for spray patching is \$5,600 per load. Supervisor will assess road conditions on the Road Tour this spring and proceed accordingly.

11. .GOV WEBSITE

By June 1, 2026, all government entities must have a .gov website. The Clerk has been exploring an update of the Township website that would feature fillable forms, electronic payments, and a more secure website and email system. The Clerk will report more specifics at the next meeting.
