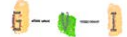

Ordinance 2: Establishing a Permit for Driveways Abutting Town Roads

**Adopted Following a Public Hearing on February 1, 2000
Amended after a Public Hearing on September 5, 2000**

Ordinance No. 2 Permit for Driveways Abutting Town Roads

In accordance with Minnesota State Statute 164.36, all activities on a town right-of-way are regulated by the Town Board. Any construction or excavation activity within the town road right-of-way may occur by permit only.

To obtain a permit application, contact the Township Clerk or Town Board Chair. Cost of the permit is \$50 payable to Watab Township. Failure to comply with this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.

The township inspector will determine if a culvert is needed, and if so, the necessary size. The proposed driveway location must be in a safe location, as determined by the township inspector. No driveway construction can begin until the application is approved and the permit fee paid. It is understood that the township road will be restored to satisfactory conditions.

This ordinance does not apply in areas with curb and gutter.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2**PERMIT FOR DRIVEWAYS ABUTTING TOWN ROADS**

In accordance with Minnesota State Statute 164.36, all activities on town right-of-way are regulated by the Town Board. Any construction or excavation activity within the town road right-of-way may occur by permit only.

To obtain a permit application, contact the Town Board Chair. Cost of the permit is \$50 payable to Watab Township. Failure to obtain a permit before construction of the driveway will result in the permit fee increasing to \$100 and, if unpaid, being assessed through property taxes.

The Town Board Chair will determine if a culvert is needed, and if so, the necessary size. The purpose of the driveway permit is also to determine a safe driveway location. No driveway construction can begin until the application is approved and the permit fee paid. It is also understood that the town road will be restored to satisfactory condition.

This ordinance does not apply in areas with curb and gutter.

Adopted and effective September 5, 2000.
